



4. The Fellow shall not accept or hold any appointment (paid or otherwise) or receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc., from any other source during the tenure of the award. However, a doctoral fellow may undertake teaching assignments for not more than four hours a week, assisting in tutorials, evaluation of the papers, laboratory/demonstration work, etc., which may help the scholar as a teacher in future.

7. The fellow, without prior permission of ICSSR, shall not join any other course of study or appear in any examination conducted by any University or Public body. Contravention of this rule will lead to automatic termination of fellowship.

8. The tenure of a regular doctoral fellowship is strictly for **two years** only and will not be extended under any circumstances.

9. If it appears to the ICSSR at any point of time that the progress or conduct of the fellow has not been satisfactory, his/her fellowship may be suspended or terminated forthwith.

10. Leave could be granted to the Fellow for a maximum period of thirty days in a year subject to the approval of the supervisor. These will be in addition to general holidays observed by the officiating institutes/university. This leave, if not utilized within a year, cannot be carried forward to the subsequent year. The general holidays, however, do not include the vacation period, e.g. summer, winter, and pooja vacations. Any leave in excess of the annual limit of 30 days, taken for whatever reasons, will be without the Fellowship. Alternatively, the period of Fellowship may be extended by a period equal to the duration of such leave depending on the merits of each case.

11. Institutional fellows must stay and work full time at the affiliating institute. However, they may go on field work with the express approval of their supervisor. For rest of the period they must stay and work at the concerned Institute.

12. On the completion of the study, the doctoral fellow shall submit a copy of his/her thesis to the Council, duly approved by their supervisor.

13. The University/ Institution to which the grant is sanctioned and released shall submit to the Council an Audited Statement of Accounts and Utilization Certificate in GFR 19A form, duly signed by the statutory auditors.

- I. In case, the statutory auditors of the Organization do not inspect the accounts every year, a simple statement of accounts and utilization certificate duly signed either by the Finance Officer or Head of the Organization, quoting page numbers of the annual accounts in which the receipt of grant and expenditure were recorded, have to be submitted to the ICSSR.
- II. If later, during the course of statutory audit any discrepancy regarding the utilization of the grant is disclosed, it should immediately be brought to the notice of the ICSSR.

14. The Institute/University to which the grant is released shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the Government grants and should keep the books open for Audit by the CAG of India and/or the ICSSR.

15. The amount of grant sanctioned herein is to be utilized within the stipulated period. Any amount of the grant remaining unspent during this period is to be refunded to the ICSSR along with the simple statement of expenditure, immediately after completion of the Programme. In case, the grantee fails to utilize the grant, it should be refunded to the ICSSR with **interest thereupon @10% p.a.** from the date of sanction of the grant.

**SANCTION ORDER**

Subject: Sanction of ICSSR Centrally Administered Doctoral Fellowship to 'NAHIDA', Department of Linguistics to work on study entitled "GENDER, POWER AND IDENTITY: A LINGUISTIC PERSPECTIVE".

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am happy to convey that NAHIDA has been awarded a Centrally Administered Doctoral Fellowship by the ICSSR for a period of Two years. The sanction letter is being issued initially for ONE YEAR with effect from 19/12/2015 to 18/12/2016 to work on the above mentioned topic. The Fellowship is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The grant is allocated as follows:  
Fellowship Grant @ Rs.16,000/-p.m. for 12 months: Rs. 1,92,000/-  
Contingency Grant @ Rs.15,000/-p.a.: Rs. 15,000/-  
**Total Grant: Rs.2,07,000/-**
2. The sanctioned grant of Rs 2,07,000/- will be released in the following manner:  
First installment - 1,00,000/-  
Second installment - 92,000/-  
Third installment - 15,000/-  
a) The first installment of Rs. 1,00,000/- will be released on receipt of the 'Grant-in-aid Bill' (proforma enclosed) duly completed, signed and stamped by the competent authority, viz., The Registrar/Principal/Director of the University/College/Institute, across a revenue stamp of usual denomination.
- b) The second installment of Rs.92,000/- will be released only after completion of six months and on receipt of detailed six-monthly progress report clearly indicating the work already done and the work to be done as well as the simple statement of expenditure incurred against the first installment released, both duly forwarded by the supervisor. The Grant in aid bill for the amount of second installment should be duly forwarded by the competent authority.

3. The renewal of the Fellowship for the subsequent year shall be subject to the receipt of annual progress report and statement of accounts for the entire grant released, which should be duly found satisfactory. The renewal has to be sought before the expiry of the first year of the Fellowship. Retrospective Extension shall not be allowed. Upon Extension, the **third installment** of the first year as well as the **first installment** of the second year amounting to Rs 1,00,000/- will be released on receipt of Grant in aid bill for both the installments.

In case, the scholar leaves the Fellowship during the first year to take up a job, without prior approval of ICSSR, the scholar shall have to refund the entire amount of grant availed to the affiliating institution. The affiliating institution, in turn, should return the amount through a cheque/draft in favour of 'ICSSR, New Delhi' immediately.

4. The draw of the monthly Fellowship and the Contingency Grant shall be governed by the rules of the affiliating institute/University.

5. The Fellow shall do full-time research work under the approved Guide on the topic mentioned above. Any modification/change in the topic of research shall need Council's prior approval.


